Paper:Quarter Sheets and Half Sheets Cold Press or MediumLight Weight to Heavy Weight, 110gsm, 180gsm, 300gsmBoahong/Master's Choice, Saunders, Arches.

Palette and Set Up:

Art Spectrum Colour Keeper (Palette will need to have some clean mixing areas and wells for colour)

14.	Cobalt Turquoise Light (Winsor and Newton)
