Perspex (also known as Acrylic – from Bunnings). Approximate size 40 x 60 cm (to fit 28 x 38 cm paper) or other **SEALED** surfaces.

Water Pots, Spray bottle, Kitchen Towel, Tissues, Masking Tape, Masking Fluid, Palette Knife or an old credit card, Granulation Medium (by W&N). Something to prop the board up at a reasonable angle or a table easel. A palette of your choice and a couple of small saucers. A small notebook for notes.
