  - Ultramarine Blue
  - Viridian or Phalo Green
  - Raw Sienna
  - Alizarin Crimson
  - Cadmium Yellow Pale or Lemon
  - o Burnt Sienna
  - o Gouache White
  - However, bring whatever watercolours you enjoy using!

## • Brushes:

- Medium mop or Chinese go bamboo brush
- 1 inch goat hair hake
- Cheap hog hair fan brush
- o Rigger or dagger liner (sword brush) brush
- However, bring other brushes if you have them
- Paper:
  - Any rough paper is fine eg saunders arches etc half sheets per day
- Other:
  - o iPad (if you have one they're really useful and very cheap now)
  - o Board really helps if sealed on one side (paint or varnish etc)
  - Sense of humour
