Oil Portraits: Finding a Likeness through Negative Space with Jennifer Fyfe

Class Description

In the studio environment, artists will be challenged to master distractions, such as movement, timeconstraints, lighting, unfamiliar equipment etc. They will learn oil painting basics and practice traditional visual techniques to hone their accuracy.

Artists will begin by drawing the model in a loose, unstructured manner.

Artists will then move on to using oil paints to capture a shadow outline of the model's facial features. Concentrating primarily on darks and lights, the artists will create a painted resemblance of their model which can then be used as a springboard to explore contemporary imagery or further traditional portraiture.

This workshop is best suited to painters with some experience in oils.

Materials List

Artists will bring their own paints, palette, brushes, medium, odourless turps, rags, and canvas of approx. 35cm x 45cm.

- Cadmium Red
