### **Materials for you to bring**

Please note there will be some materials provided by the teacher. However you will still need to bring...

- A3 Sketch book (cartridge paper)
- Graphite (greylead) pencil and eraser (ideally keedable)
- Ruler (ideally metal for when you use a scalpel)
- Scissors, glue stick, cardboard surface for gluing and cutting
- Scalpel for trimming your mock-up book
- You are welcome to bring some colour pencils or colour markers etc to add some colour to your mock up.
- You are welcome to bring in the text of your own children's picture book to work on (teacher will also provide a classic fairytale to work on if you prefer)
