rounds sizes $6,10,12$
flat wash 2 cm or hake
mop size 10
fan size 8
rigger size 8
Taklon (nylon) bristle brushes are perfectly fine. Animal hair bristles sable, squirrel, pony or goat hair) hold more paint and feel lovely to paint with but are more expensive. Buy the best you can afford.
