PAPER: your most important material!! you MUST use <u>RAG PAPER</u> <u>100% COTTON. Do not use cheaper paper it will give you disappointing</u> <u>results.</u>

Recommended brands: <u>ARCHES</u> or <u>SAUNDERS</u> 300gsm medium surface at least A3 size or full sheets divided into 4 (available in packs of 10)

RECOMMENDED BRANDS: Winsor & Newton, Daniel Smith, Holbein

BRUSHES:

rounds sizes 6, 10, 12 flat wash 2cm or hake mop size 10 fan size 8 rigger size 8

Taklon (nylon) bristle brushes are perfectly fine. Animal hair bristles sable, squirrel, pony or goat hair) hold more paint and feel lovely to paint with but are more expensive. <u>Buy the best you can afford.</u>

ALSO.....

white palette with lid with at least 12 colour wells board (ply, MDF or Fome core) a little larger than A3 masking tape tissues plastic water container 2B pencil & kneadable eraser for sketching up a notebook is useful! a small sketchbook A5 size will do
