Landscape and Seascape in Watercolour







Each session will begin with breezy sketch studies exploring composition and colouring in preparation for the main painted subject. The sessions are designed to introduce better colour, mood and atmospherics in watercolour painting. Participants will be guided through these exercises which in turn will give them the space to develop their watercolour technique and expertise.

Brushes, Paper, and Palette will be discussed while demonstrating and assisting various techniques of the medium. This is an ideal class for beginners and those looking to re-visit watercolour basics and develop their technique.
