MEDIUM

- ☐ (brand) Golden Glazing Liquid - either gloss or satin is fine.
Take note this medium brand is **highly HIGHLY** recommended!

Please feel free to bring what you may already have at home. Where possible try to have a range of brushes in various shapes and sizes. If you need/want an idea on sizes and shapes or a suggestion on what to purchase

- ☐ Hogs hair Filbert sizes 10 and/or 8
- ☐ Hogs hair Flat sizes 10 and/or 8
- ☐ Hogs hair Round sizes 10 and/or 8 and smaller sizes 2 and 4
- ☐ Synthetic Filbert brushes sizes 10 and/or 8
- ☐ Synthetic Flat brushes sizes 10 and/or 8
- ☐ Synthetic Round 20, 8, 2, 4
- ☐ 30mm Broad synthetic brush for glazing

SUPPORT

- ☐ A3 or A4 Acrylic Painting Pad (I use Artist Spectrum)
- ☐ 1x Canvas board for end of term project (Suggested size - 16" x 20" or 14" x 18")

DRAWING

- ☐ A graphite pencil or two to draw with. (Suggestions H, HB, 2B)
