# Materials List

#### **Brushes**

 Neef Stiff Synthetics recommended if you do not have any brushes, feel free to bring other brushes that you have on hand already

## **Oil Paint Colours**

I recommend Art Spectrum/ Gamblin 1980 as a minimum standard

- Required colours:
  - White
  - o Cad Red
  - Yellow Ochre
  - o Black
  - o Ultramarine Blue
- Optional colours:
  - Cad Yellow (alternative Hansa Yellow)
  - Viridian
  - o Alizarin Crimson
  - Transparent Brown Oxide
  - Transparent Red Oxide

## **Palette**

Either grey or wood in colour, avoid a white palette

#### **Substrate**

- Any substrate of your choice eg. stretched canvas, canvas board
- Oil Paper taped onto a board can be an economical option
- Any size in between 9x12 12x16

### Other

- Linseed oil
- Palette knife, something suitable for mixing paint
- Paper towel
- Separate plastic bags for dirty brushes and palette to take home
- Tupperware container and baking paper if you want to save leftover paint to take home (optional)
