

Linda Weil's Drawing Practice

Essential Material Requirements

*Please ensure you bring all materials for each class

- Drawing board, at least A3 size. Note: cardboard is not acceptable.
- Prop or desk easel for your board
- Graphite pencils, range to include: 2H, H, F, HB, 2B, 4B. Pencils should be one brand only, it is not recommended you mix brands. Avoid cheap Reject shop pencils or the like. Recommended: Staedtler Mars
- A blue pencil – any brand
- Masking tape and bulldog clips
- Pencil sharpener (or blade and sand paper block)
- White poly eraser
- Kneadable eraser
- Blue tack (Bostick brand, traditional blue only)
- Tracing paper
- Paper stump (tortillion)
- Visual Diary, A4 size. Windsor Newton Heavyweight 165gsm diary from Officeworks recommended
- A3 Hot press (smooth) paper. 250gsm or 300gsm. Note I usually use either a 300gsm Lana Hot press watercolour or a 300gsm Fabriano Artistico hot press watercolour paper for my finished works. Available in large sheets that can be cut into 4 A3 sheets. If unsure please discuss with me on first session.
