# Materials List

### Brushes

 Neef Stiff Synthetics recommended if you do not have any brushes, feel free to bring other brushes that you have on hand already

# Oil Paint Colours

I recommend Art Spectrum/ Gamblin 1980 as a minimum standard

- Required colours:
  - White
  - Cad Red
  - Yellow Ochre
  - Black
  - Ultramarine Blue
  - Transparent Brown Oxide
  - Transparent Red Oxide
- Optional colours:
  - Cad Yellow (alternative Hansa Yellow)
  - Viridian
  - Alizarin Crimson

#### **Palette**

• Either grey or wood in colour, avoid a white palette

# **Substrate**

- · Any substrate of your choice eg. stretched canvas, canvas board
- · Oil Paper taped onto a board can be an economical option
- Any size in between 9x12 12x16

### Other

- Linseed oil
- Palette knife, something suitable for mixing paint
- Paper towel
- Separate plastic bags for dirty brushes and palette to take home
- Tupperware container and baking paper if you want to save leftover paint to take home (optional)
